The Economic Society of Thessaloniki invites papers for its biannual conference, which is to take place in December 17-19, 2009 in Thessaloniki. The theme of this year's Conference will be:

#### **Global Crisis and Economic Policies**

Papers that explore the root causes of the recent economic crisis, its impact on the real and monetary economy and the various economic policies at the macroeconomic or the microeconomic level are particularly welcome. Among the topics of interest are included:

- · Causes of the global crisis
- · The consequences on employment
- · The financial system and its restructuring
- Economic policies: The role of private and public sector
- · Towards a new Breton Woods?
- · The green economy and its potential leading role
- The impact of economic crisis on developing countries

In this conference we will also consider papers that do not fall in the theme of the conference.

#### **Conference Language**

The official languages of the Conference will be Greek and English.

### **Paper Selection**

A scientific committee will evaluate all submitted papers and select a limited number of them for presentation.

The Conference will also provide room for invited papers.

The Economic Society of Thessaloniki will select for publication a collection of the papers presented at the Conference.

#### **Submission Procedure**

Abstracts should be submitted by **September 30**<sup>th</sup>. Abstracts (of no more than 250 words) should mention: title of communication, name(s) of the author(s), affiliation, corresponding author's e-mail address, postal address, telephone number. Corresponding authors will be informed of the decision of the scientific committee by **October 30**<sup>th</sup>. Full papers should be received by November 30<sup>th</sup>.

### **Submission Fees:**

The submission fee for members of Society is 120 euros, for non-members 150 euros and for students 50 euros.
